**We do not accept nominations for specific denominational, national or international charities e.g. Canadian Cancer Society.**
- Each member may submit the name of 2 charities for consideration over the coming year. The member must have a personal association with each charity. - Nominations that come in **less than 10 days** before the upcoming meeting will only be considered for the following meeting. Time is needed to contact the presenter and for her to prepare her “pitch”.
- Junior members are also encouraged to nominate a charity. Their pitches will be only 1 minute.
- Charities not selected on one night are invited to re-submit for consideration again at future meetings.
